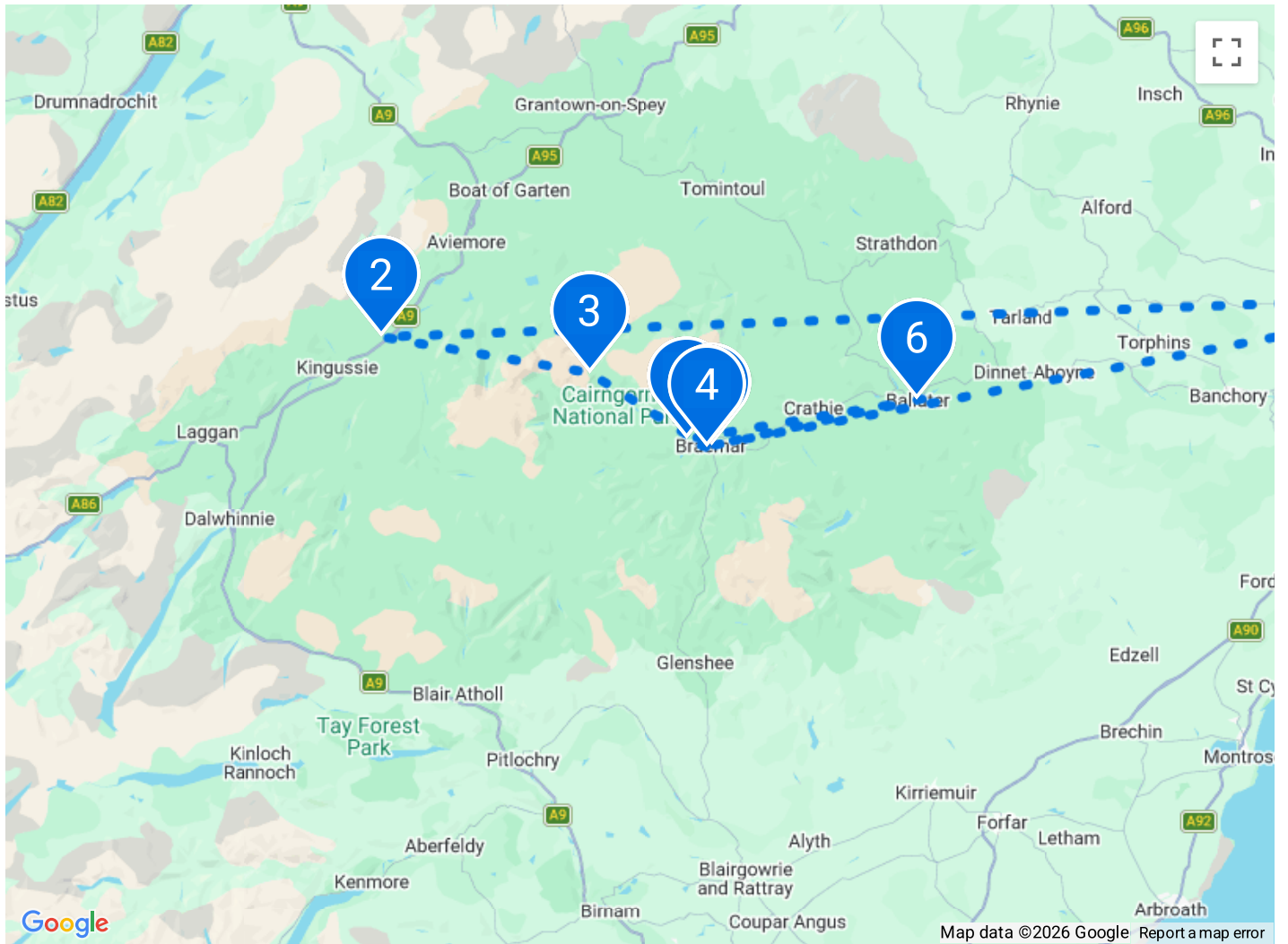

Cairngorms National Park

An exciting day of downhill trekking, featuring a breathtaking change of scenery. We will traverse a primeval Scots pine forest that will lead us to a magnificent camping location. Weather permitting, we will have the opportunity to refresh ourselves and take a dip in the stream, fully immersing ourselves in the natural beauty of the Scottish Highlands. Camp dinner and overnight stay in a tent.

Braemar

We will end the day camping near a cottage that was once frequented by Prince Charles, in a charming natural setting. Camp dinner and overnight stay in a tent.

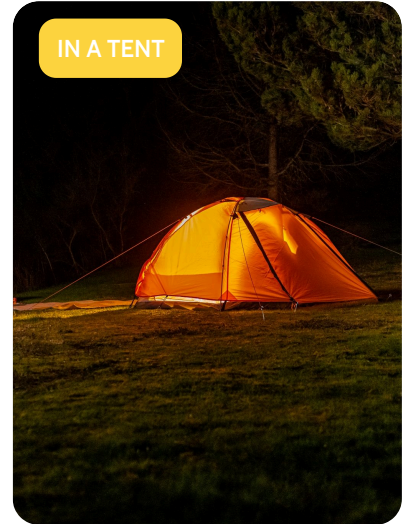

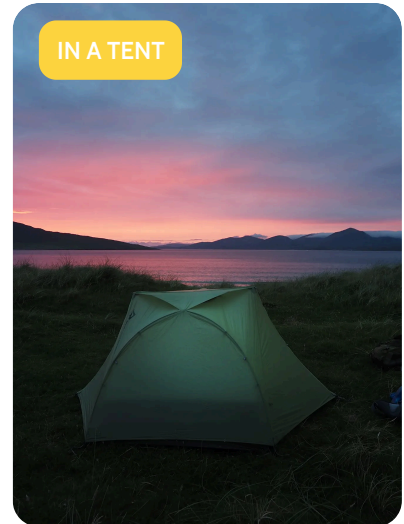

✓ Features of the trip

Open to adult travelers with some training, subject to an interview with the Guides. You will travel in a group, with full support from the agency and accompanied by 2 Environmental Hiking Guides. During a group holiday, you may meet people from different countries with customs different from your own. Respect everyone's space and have fun. The tour is organized by local Guides and Operators, carefully selected for you.

Remember to bring a passport with an expiration date of at least 6 months from the departure date. The itinerary may be subject to changes before and/or during the trip.
